- Documents have been selected and catalogued by subject specialist editors, with expert commentaries provided to guide users through serial content.
- Millions of pages of digitized primary and secondary material in a mix of English and vernacular languages dating back to the 18th Century, up to the mid-20th Century.
- Derived from original archive materials held by the South Asia Research Foundation
- Online access to previously unavailable resources in South Asian studies.




**Smt. Hansa Mehta Library**, the University Library of the Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda was established on May 1, 1950. At the time of establishment of The Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda, a collection of 25,000 books belonging to the Two State Libraries (Huzur Political Office and Secretariat Library) was handed over to the University Library. There were several colleges in Baroda – Baroda College (for Arts), Science Institute, Commerce College and Secondary Teacher’s Training College etc. These Colleges had libraries of their own. These libraries continued to remain as Faculty Libraries and were administered independently. Thus the University Library System was established on 1-5-1950, which was housed in the central block of Old Residency Office Building.

It is the first University Library in the State to provide Wi-Fi facility, Air conditioned reading areas which are Solar enabled. Library is under surveillance through closed circuit television with the help of 24 cameras located strategically around various functional areas.

The Library is identified as Document Delivery Center with 26 other Universities in the country to provide Inter Library Loan service from Print journals subscribed in University Library System.

To serve the visually challenged, KIBO XS Device has been procured. To facilitate readers in reading E-books, Kindles have been procured and made available in Academia Unit.

The Library has a rich collection of bound journals of more than one lakh, out of which some are as old as Nineteenth Century available till date. A few illustrative are as mentioned below –

- Journal of Royal Asiatic Society, Volume 1 - 1834 onwards
- Annals of the American Academy of Political and Social Science, Volume 1 – 1890 onwards
- Economic Journal, Volume 4 – 1894 onwards
- Geographical Journal, Volume 1 – 1893 onwards
- Proceedings of the Aristotelian Society, Volume 1 – 1890 onwards

With a collection of more than 8 lacs documents, more than 3000 unique research journals in at least 30 subject areas, academic clientele of approx. 40,000 students, teachers, 13 constituent libraries and professional staff of more than 50 persons, the Maharaja Sayajirao University Library System is one of the richest and biggest in the country.

- 30,000+ manuscripts of Oriental Institute digitized with the help of National Mission on Manuscripts
- Open Knowledge Gateway (OKG): Open Knowledge Gateway (OKG) provides platform to the researchers, faculty and students of MSU to access the free academic resources available on internet without geographical limitations since 2013. Many free e-resources are accessible through OKG.
- Institutional Repository (IR) : An IR has been developed in 2013 for exploring the Scholarly Publications of MSU faculty and activated on HML Website which is mandatory as per NAAC committee. 397 theses have been uploaded.
- University Library secured 7th rank among Top 10 must-visit biggest Libraries of India in a survey conducted by India Today magazine (July 16, 2016).
- Annual Reports are accessible on Library website.
- Digitization and uploading of all the doctoral theses on the Shodhganga available at Smt. Hansa Mehta Library, Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda is accomplished through ProQuest. Shodhganga is the project for digitization of Doctoral theses of all Indian Universities by INFLIBNET. The work involved digitization of 3265 theses with creation of metadata adhering to Shodhganga format.
- PQDT has identified this University Library for downloading highest number of theses in the country.

It has a single largest Reading Room of 10,600 sq ft., which can accommodate 1100 readers at a time and is open for readers from 8:00 am to 8:00 pm. i.e. 12 hours a day throughout the year except National Holidays. It is situated in the whole North Side of the building, in order to have a continuous natural light throughout the year. It is the First University Library in the State which is fully air conditioned and solar enabled.
